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Advice to Mureeds

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1.ADVICE TO MUREEDS

On page 311 of "Destruction or Peace" the word Islam has been defined as :

"I"	stands for "I"
"S"	stands for "Shall"
"L"	stands for "Love"
"A"	stands for "All"
"M"	stands for "Mankind"
"M"	stands for "Mankind"

As such "Islam" stands for : "I shall love all Mankind".

There is nothing more wonderful than love. It removes all the barriers of caste, colour or creed between man and man. It removes hatred, mistrusts and doubts and replaces them with understanding. Love helps to make man into a single brotherhood of goodwill. It raises the status of man from beasts to angels. If this can be practised on a worldwide basis by our leaders, it can bring about world peace and harmony.

When you do a thing out of love then only you can put your whole heart and soul into it. From a religious point of view, this naturally makes your prayers into a living thing which thrills you from head to foot as you adore your Creator. Now compare it with the prayers which are observed as a routine and which in course of time become drudgery because you do not understand so you cannot actively partake in the significance of the same. So the net results are that you have to do the prayers out of fear of hell and out of the temptations of getting a reward in Heaven with its palaces, its Hurs and Gulmans and its fruits etc. But the most significant fact still remains that these prayers have not been performed out of love of Allah; hence according to Sufi ideas there is no sense or utility in observing such prayers and penances, which achieve for you nothing in this life or in the next.

Hazrat Bibi Rabiya Basri (R.A.) has often brought this out in her repeated declarations as follows :

"Oh Allah if I pray to Thee for fear of Hell, Then cast me into Hell.

"Oh Allah if I pray to Thee out of temptations for the comforts and pleasure of Heaven, Then deprive me from Heaven.

> "Oh Allah if I pray to Thee out of love for Thee, Then deny me not Thy sight".

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Kindly carefully study pages 420 to 428 of "Destruction or Peace" to understand not only the meaning of the Prayers but its background and also its significance and how one can participate and lose oneself and achieve "Meraj-ul-Mominin".

Love is the giving of yourself unto your loved one. Pure love means only doing those things that would please the loved one and refraining from that which displeases him. In other words – complete surrender of all your thoughts, words and deeds unto the wishes of your Murshid. When you pray, imagine that it is not you who is praying but that it is your Murshid who is praying through and with you. Thus in course of time you will lose your identity in him, and realise that it is he who is praying.

This is the first stage and is known as "Fana Fil Shaikh". To achieve it one has to model his or her life according to the "Sunnah" of the Holy Prophet Muhammad (Sallal La Ho Alaihae Wasallam). This amongst others comprises of :

- 1. The establishment of Prayers (Akumus Salaata) i.e. :
 - a. Prayers to be performed punctually without any fear for hell or the temptations of heaven.
 - b. Prayers to be out of pure love for Allah without any thoughts for a reward of any kind.
 - c. Understanding what you are praying.
 - d. Mental participation in the different acts of the Prayers with its significances e.g. :
 - e. That you are standing before your Lord and that Allah is watching what you are doing.
 - f. That when you bow before Him and recite "Subhana Rabbial Azeem" (Glory be to the Sustainer Lord, the Omnipotent) that Allah gives a reply "Sami Allahu Liman Hamida" which means "Allah listens to him who praises Him". If Allah is listening to our prayers and He personally acknowledge it, then is not our adoration already accepted by Allah? Yes! Most certainly such a prayer has been accepted by Allah! Only after Allah's reply has been given then one should start getting up from the bowing position giving a reply to Allah as "Rabbana lakal Hamd".
 - g. Then when one falls prostrate in Sajada during his prayers, to

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imagine that he is falling upon Allah's feet (even though Allah has no shape). This will bring a feeling of nearness to Allah.

- h. The first Sajada in each rikat of prayer is "Sajada Abdi" or the created prostrating before his Creator in absolute submission to Allah. But the second Sajada carries quite a different significance. It is the Sajada of Shukur or "Sajada of joy out of thanksgiving". It is to be performed by saying "Allah ho Akbar" after the first Sajada and rising to the sitting position.
- i. Then repeating "Allah Ho Akbar". The significance of the two "Allah Ho Akbar" are different. The first means "Allah is Greatest" but when the second "Allah Ho Akbar" is repeated it carries a great emphasis and means "**Of course without any doubt** Allah is the Greatest". With this emphasis the worshipper should throw himself with his whole heart, mind and soul at the feet of Allah in thanksgiving in the second Sajada because Allah has blessed the worshipper with strength of body to be able to adore his Creator in such a manner of complete and absolute surrender or Sajada-e-Shukur.
- j. When you are sitting and reading "Attahiyyatu ..." it means that you are placing before your Lord "All services rendered by you by words and bodily actions and sacrifices of wealth in honour of Allah". This brings out :
 - i. What we had prayed in a standing position earlier viz.:

"Iyyaaka naabudu wa iyyaaka nastaaeen" "Ihdinas Siratal Moostaqeem" "Siraatal lazeena anaamta alaihim" Translation : "Thee we worship, Thee we ask for help. "(What is the help we are asking Allah? It is) Guide us to one (i.e. our Murshid) on the Straight Path.



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"(What is meant by the Straight path is clarified as) The path of those (saints) whom Thou hast favoured with Thy Grace"

(Sura 1 – Al Fateha : Ayats 4-6)

ii. It is expected of every Murid or true believer that he should love his Creator with all his heart and soul viz. :

"Say of course my Salaat and my sacrifices and my living and my dying are all consecrated to Allah, the Lord of the entire Universe"

(Sura 6 – Al An'am : Ayat 163)

k. When the Holy Prophet (Peace be upon Him) offered "Attahiyyaatu" on the night of Meraj before the throne of Allah, Allah replied:

"Assalaamu Alaika ya ayyuhan Nabiyyu wa Rahmatullaahi wa Barakaatuh"

Translation :

"My peace be on thee Oh Prophet together with My Mercy and My Blessings" – indeed what a great honour!

I. When Muhammad^(S.A.W.) found that he alone was being blessed by Allah, whilst he was "Rahmat UI Lil Aalaameen" (A Comforter and Blessing for the whole Universe) he pleaded immediately with Allah :

"Assalaamu Alaina alaa ibaadil-Laahis saaleheen"

Translation :

"Let the Peace of Allah be on the worshippers and the righteous servants of the Lord" – thus covering all righteous worshippers of Allah including angel Gabriel and all other angels as well as Adam the first man till the last true worshipper at the time of the

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destruction of the Universe – indeed a Rahmat Ul Lil Aalaameen – A Comforter and Saviour for the entire creation!

m. When Muhammad^(S.A.W.) made such a big request that the Universe be blessed through him, Allah naturally asked what gift have you got to offer in exchange? Muhammad's^(S.A.W.) forthright reply was :

"Ash-hadu an la illaha illal Laahu"

Translation :

"I give evidence that none is worthy of divine worship except Allah".

So exceptionally was Allah overjoyed that He announced :

"Wa ash-hadu anna Muhammadan^(S.A.W.) abduhoo wa rasooluh".

Translation :

"And I (also) give evidence that $Muhammad^{(S.A.W.)}$ is His (Allah's) slave and His Messenger".

Thus Muhammad^(S.A.W.) was given the unique honour of being declared the slave of Allah, in addition to being His Messenger.

n. So pleased was Allah at the Prayer of Muhammad^(S.A.W.) for the blessing of all righteous servants of the Lord (from Gabriel the first Angel and Adam till the last believer in the universe when it will be destroyed) and the gift of Muhammad^(S.A.W.) (the evidence of the declaration of the Oneness of Allah) that He issued the following Quranic Order not only upon the crowd of Angels and spiritual dwellers of the Universe, who were gathered and watching from a distance, but it was also an order for all time to come on all believers in Allah as well as on all mankind for all time to come.

"Lo! Allah and His angels send 'Salaat' (i.e. prayers of glorification) on the Prophet. O Ye who believe ! Send 'Salaat' (i.e. prayers of glorification) on him (i.e. the Holy Promised Prophet Muhammad^(S.A.W.)) and offer 'Salimu' (i.e. peace of Allah and salutation) to him in a worthy



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(respectful) salutation."

(Sura 33 – Al Ahzab : Ayat 56)

o. The Angels responded to the above order and chanted the following blessings upon the honoured guest of Allah as under :

"Allaahoomma salli alaa sayedena Muhammadin^(S.A.W.) wa alaa aali sayedena Muhammadin^(S.A.W.) kama sallayta alaa sayedena Ibrahim wa alaa aali sayedena Ibrahima innaka Hameedum Majeed.

"Alaahoomma baarik alaa sayedena Muhammadin^(S.A.W.) wa alaa aali sayedena Muhammadin^(S.A.W.) kama baarakta alaa sayedena Ibrahima wa alaa aali sayedena Ibrahima innaka Hameedum Majeed".

Translation :-

"Oh Allah ! Exalt Muhammad^(S.A.W.) and the children of Muhammad^(S.A.W.) as Thou didst exalt Abraham and the children of Abraham ! Surely Thou art the Praised, the Magnified.

"Oh Allah ! Bless Muhammad^(S.A.W.) and the children of Muhammad^(S.A.W.) as Thou didst bless Abraham and the children of Abraham ! Surely Thou art the Praised, the Magnified".

p. When the Angels finished then Muhammad^(S.A.W.) recited the following momentous prayer whilst still in the sitting posture before the Almighty :

"Rabbanaa aatena fidduniya hasanatown wa fil akeratah hasanatown waqina azabin nar.

"Allahummag firli wale waalediya wale ustadhziya wale mantawwalada wal jammial momineena wal mominaate wal muslemeena wal rnuslemaate al-ah-ya min hum wal amwat innaka samium mujibad daaawat be rahmateka ya arhamar rahemeen".

Translation :

"Oh our Sustainer Lord grant us in this Earth what is good for us and in the life hereafter what is good for us and save us from the tortures of the Fire (of Hell).

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"Oh Allah forgive us our sins and also of our parents, and also of our teachers, and also of our families and (also of) the whole gathering of those men who do good deeds and those women who do good deeds and also of those men who have surrendered themselves to Your Will (i.e. the Muslims) and also of those women who have surrendered themselves to Your Will (i.e. the Muslims) all those of them who are alive and (all those of them) who have passed away indeed Thou art the Granter, Hearer of Prayers (and bless them all) with your Blessing Oh Most Beneficent, Most Merciful".

- q. Not only to pray seriously when one is in difficulty but to establish your prayers when you are at the height of success and extremely busy making money or getting fame.
- r. To be careful to establish Salaat regularly even during travelling or in discomfort or sickness. If you do not have the strength to stand and pray then sit or lie and pray and thus always maintain the regularity of prayers.
- s. It is mentioned in all the authentic Hadith that Namaaz is "As Salaatu Meraj ul Momineen" – "Namaaz is the Meraj of the Momin (i.e. believers)". Salaat is the route to attain exaltation in all of one's endeavours. Salaat is an established route to unite the believers with their Lord. Salaat is one authentic way for all believers to talk with their Creator.
- t. Full details of how to establish Salaat is outlined in Musharaf-ul-Mahboobin (1985 in Urdu).
- 2. To be careful to observe the Ramadan Fasts.
- 3. To effect the proper and due payment of Zakat.
- 4. To perform the Hajj pilgrimage at least once in your lifetime, and visit the shrine of the Holy Prophet Muhammad (S.A.W.) in Medina, if it is within your means.
- 5. To have love and respect for your elders and loving consideration to all dependents and young ones in the family. To serve, love and honour your parents above all, approach them with courtesy at all times, and take their blessings always.
- 6. To love your neighbours.

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- 7. The feeding of the poor.
- 8. Honesty in dealing especially with property of orphans and widows.
- 9. The observing of good, honest conduct in all your worldly dealings.
- 10. The discharging of your trusts.
- 11.The keeping your words.
- 12.Not to replace good with bad in your management of others' properties especially of orphans and wakfs and trusts.
- 13.Do only that which is Halaal (i.e. permitted). Avoid all that is Haraam (i.e. forbidden) such as jealousy, evil thoughts, backbiting, slandering, false witness and oaths, snatching away the rights of others, taking bribes, fornication etc. Refrain from all that is wrong.
- 14.Always stay 'paak' (i.e. pure) and with Wazoo during your waking hours as far as possible.
- 15.To follow all the Farz (i.e. obligatory acts of Islam) strictly, and try your best to follow all the Sunnah (i.e. optional but highly recommended acts of Islam) strictly, in your daily life. To strictly stay on the path of the Shari'ah of the Holy Prophet Muhammad (S.A.W.) in every manner.
- 16.To adore and respect the Holy Prophet (S.A.W.) with all your heart and soul, knowing full well that this in turn will lead to adoration and respect of Allah Ta'ala.

This may be summed up briefly as trying your best to lead as perfect and noble a life as possible according to the Sunnah of the Prophet.

Then slowly as practice makes one perfect so also the Murids as they get accustomed to lead an Islamic system of life, they are bound to experience the spiritual upliftment of their souls. That is the sole object with which the Murid had been searching for a Murshid to guide him to "Siratul Mustakim" and having found one and having done baiyat upon the hands of the Murshid to hope that the Murids will be blessed in stages by the Almighty Allah with "Fana Fil Moula" and even "Fana Fil Rasul". The eventual blessings being "Fana Fil Allah" as taught in the Holy Quran :

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"......Allah will bring forth people whom He loves and who love Him, humble towards believers, firm in their faith who cannot be influenced by disbelievers, who do jehad upon their nafs in the way of Allah (as directed by their Murshids) and fearing not the blame of any blamer. Such is the Grace of Allah, which He giveth unto whom He Wills. Allah is All-Embracing, All-knowing"

(Sura 5 – Al Maidah : Ayat 54)

" Allah has pleasure in them and they have pleasure in Him. This is (in store) for him who loveth His Lord"

(Sura 98 – Al Baiyinah : Ayat 8)

"But ah : thou Soul at Peace:

"Return unto thy Lord content in His good pleasures"

(Sura 89 - Al Fajr : Ayats 27 and 28)

Hazrat Ibn Abbas (R.A.) has informed that the Holy Prophet (Peace be upon Him) had stated to the "Ashab-us-Safa" i.e. the first Sufis as follows :

"Rejoice : for whoever of my community perseveres in the state in which ye are, and is satisfied with his condition, he shall be one of my comrades in Paradise" (page 565 of "Destruction or Peace").

Here are a few quotations from renowned Sufi Saints :

"Sufi is a name which is given, and has formerly been given, to the perfect saints and spiritual adepts.

"He that is purified by love is pure and he that is absorbed in the Beloved and has abandoned all else is a Sufi" (Page 34 Kashf Al-Mahjub by Ali Al-

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Hururi urf Hazrat Data Ganj Baksh (R.A.) of Lahore translated by Prof. R. A. Nicholson on behalf of E.J.W. Gibb Memorial Trust, 1959).

"Sign of Love is that you should be fully obedient and abstain from that which may separate you from His love and friendship" – Hazrat Khwaja Usman Harooni Chishty (R.A.).

"You keep guard upon your nafs. This is the prayer of Saints" – Hazrat Khwaja Moinuddin Hasan Chishty Sanjari Ajmeri (R.A.).

"Weigh not other people's misdeeds upon your scale – Rather weigh yourself on the Scale of the Saint (i.e. your Murshid)" – Hazrat Khwaja Fariduddin Attar (R.A.).

"As long as you are the slave of your own passions how can you attain your lover?"

"Only if you will forget yourself in the love of your Lover and be drowned in His love, then only will your lover belong to none but you" - Hazrat Boo - Ali Shah Qalander (R.A.).

The Wazifa by which love can be instilled into your heart is the Darood Sharif :

"Allah Humma Salle Ala Muhammaddin^(S.A.W.) wala aale Muhammad^(S.A.W.)"

This must preferably be recited a minimum of 101 times after each Farz Salaat, or at least 505 times per day.

To recite atleast once in a day :

Subhan Allah	-	33 Times
Alhamdu Lillah	-	33 Times
Allah Ho Akbar	-	<u>34 Times</u>
Making a Total	-	100 Times

To read Khatam Khwajgan once a day in short form as indicated. In any case to read the full Khatam Khwajgan every Thursday night (Shab-e-Jumma). There is no objection to the Murid taking the assistance of relatives and friends when reading this.

To read the Fateha Khwani with Sijrah at least once a day. But in any case every Thursday night (Shab-e-Jumma).

When a Murid enters a Mosque or a Khanqah or the Shrine of the Holy Prophet (S.A.W.) or of a Saint, you must enter with your right foot and when

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you leave such holy places it should be with your left foot. Do not show your back when leaving a Shrine or a Khanqah but always with your face towards it as a mark of respect.

Try to say your prayers on the right hand side of the Imam and in the first line in Jumma Prayers which must be said in the mosque. During Jumma Khutba sit as if praying in sitting position with arms folded in first half of Khutba and with arms on laps during second half of the Khutba – This is the teachings of Saints. A little "dua" to be said in between 1st and 2nd parts of the Khutba.

Cut your hair or trim your moustache and manicure on Thursday or Fridays – it is the Sunnah. Do not do these either on Wednesday or Saturdays – it is forbidden by the Holy Prophet (S.A.W.) and can lead to sickness and loss of business.

When you start a new thing start with Bismillah.

Pick up things with your right hand as far as possible.

Dress in such a manner as will not only cover your body but the clothes should be so loose as to hide the shape of the parts of your body which require to be covered. Cover your head and button up the neck button of your dress. Your hands should be covered by long sleeves and the legs till above the ankles for men and below the ankles for women who are ordered in Quran and Hadis to draw a veil over the breasts.

Do all things that are according to Sunnah and avoid what are "Forbidden" and even abstain from things which are "Makruh".

Make it a point to earn your livelihood honestly and fairly. Try to lead a peaceful contented life in harmony with all those around you. Do not get angry nor fight unnecessarily.

Eat out of your honest earnings. Avoid such things as are harmful to your personal health even though they are "Halal" and permitted because the said thing is not "Taiyib" or good for you. This is an order of the Holy Quran.

To fast every month for three days – i.e. 13th, 14th and 15th of each lunar month. By doing this you will get the following benefits.

- 1. Good health and less sickness
- 2. Honest income with its many barkats in it
- 3. Self-control, Happiness and Contentment

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Not to eat any meat or fish or fowl or egg between sunset on Thursday until you complete Friday Prayers. But to live on Thursday night / Friday morning on vegetables and milk or other light foods to enable you to gain control over your Nafs.

Try to avoid eating beef even though it has been cut in the "Halal" manner. Even though beef is a Halal item, it creates heat and sexual desires. So it causes disturbances in one's "Ibaadat" or Prayers. Beef is also not a Sunnah because cows do not exist in Mecca or Madinah areas. So the Holy Prophet (S.A.W.) never ate beef in his life. So it is not a Sunnah.

Do not even think of any hatred or jealousy for anybody for any reason whatsoever. Thought is the mother of all actions. Remember the least bit of hatred or jealousy will destroy all your good deeds.

For men – Do not divorce your wife without the permission of your Spiritual Guide. Do not remarry or take another wife while the first wife is alive, without the permission of your Spiritual Guide.

Always be humble and meek and bear up difficulties with a smile remembering Hazrat Bibi Rabiya Basri (R.A.) when she was asked why are you rejoicing when you are under high fever and great pain. She replied : "Every day Allah used to give me the normal attention which He gives to all His creation by providing all their requirements but today Allah has paid special attention to me by giving me this high fever, great pain and other serious troubles, so is not this the right time for me to rejoice at this special honour and attention given to me by Allah".

Remember this well.

7.CHIRAG RAUSHAN

A.Introduction

The Chirag Raushan is a prayer which comprises four specific Ayats of the Holy Quran followed by Persian verses. It is to be recited at the end of each Islamic day, 15 minutes before the Adhaan for Maghrib Salaat. This is a prayer which celebrates Sura 24 An-Nur : Ayats 35 - 38, and reciting this prayer at the close of each day has been a tradition of the Chishti Order. Chirag Raushan was introduced in India by the Patron Saint of the Indian subcontinent, Khwaja Syed Moinuddin Hasan Chishty, and continues to be recited at his Holy Shrine in Ajmer every evening.
